

# 5 WAYS TO SPOT SCAM EMAILS



**1** *Do you recognize the sender?*  
**If yes, remain cautious and verify the email address before clicking any links.**  
**If not, DO NOT click any links.**



**2** *Are there any attachments in the email?*  
**If so, DO NOT click on the attachment.**



**3** *Does the email request for personal information?*  
**If so, DO NOT reply.**



**4** *Does the email contain spelling and grammatical errors?*  
**If so, be suspicious.**



**5** *Mouse over the link. Does the link URL look suspicious?*  
**If so, DO NOT click on it.**



## SCAMMING/PHISHING

Refers to fake email messages that appear to come from a legitimate company or an individual. The messages are designed to trick the recipient into giving personal information to fraudsters. Some scamming messages include malware attachments.
